Vaccines Shortage

There are currently shortages of the vaccines such a Heptavac P Plus and Footvax. Manufacturer MSD Animal Health said stock disruption was being caused by "logistics and regulatory challenges in 2021 due to Brexit that reduced safety stocks". If you are unable to get hold of Vaccines please Speak to your vet or suitably qualified person (SQP) as it will depend on what you need to cover. Any sheep that are kept and used for breeding in subsequent years will need a full primary course of Heptavac P Plus in pregnancy, if they have not already received one.

As part of conditions of sale entry you must clearly state what product used to vaccinate your sheep. If you have used other products as a result of the shortages then please state and declare this on the sale entry forms.
